## Kenya Report

Dear Friend in Christ,

Last month our prayer letter left you hanging, wondering what happened on the Kenya trip with all the drama at the beginning. Brother Jim went on to Amsterdam, then to Nairobi, meeting Charles Juma and his friends. Charles called me as soon as he saw Brother Jim. He put Brother Jim on the line, and I was greatly relieved that he had gotten there okay.

I then flew to Atlanta, got my passport "fixed," then flew out of Atlanta to Amsterdam and Nairobi. I missed the first day of the conference, but Brother Jim and a black preacher friend of Charles' forged ahead. I got in very late Tuesday night, got in bed, and was anxious to see Brother Jim early Wednesday morning. Brother Jim told me he had been sick most of the night and was not feeling well. He taught the first hour after feeling very sick at the beginning, then spent the rest of the day trying to overcome the fever. His fever broke that night, so Thursday and Friday went great.

The pastors, 130 of them, were very responsive and loved the teaching. They are requesting that we come back next August for a follow-up conference, and then go "up-country" for a 2<sup>nd</sup> week with pastors who have no Bible training at all.

Brother Jim said, "This is a tough ministry as I learned bouncing down dusty, bumpy roads, eating strange food, and experiencing different languages, lifestyles, and customs." He assured our Advisory Council that their efforts are paying "huge eternal dividends." After investing his life into theirs for a week, Brother Jim became very attached to these wonderful pastors. He told them he would never forget them or what God had done during those days.

Our second week there was with 120 pastors who were all African Inland church pastors. We had a wonderful week there in the Masinga District, with Bob Stewart and Len Morgan helping me teach. We saw God really bring them to life as they

Jimmy Dusek’s church in Franklin, NC paid for 6 Proclaimers which I took to Kenya and gave to some pastors. The Proclaimer has the entire Bible in their language (Swahili) and has a solar charger to use in areas where there is no electricity. This allows for use in remote areas where some cannot read and others do not have Bibles. I will be taking more of these to other countries with scripture in their particular language.

I am talking to some other churches and groups about investing in missions by purchasing these Proclaimers. The cost is \$157.00 per unit from “Faith Comes by Hearing” and we make nothing in this. If any of you feel led to invest in the Kingdom this way, please let us know.
